Dear Ms Jamieson,

Thank you for your email dated 9th February.

COMARE is a Department of Health and Social Care expert advisory committee whose remit is to provide independent advice to the UK government on the health effects of natural and man-made radiation – both ionising and non-ionising. COMARE was established in November 1985 and in the course of providing advice to Government and the devolved authorities for over thirty years, the committee has published 18 major reports and many other statements and documents. Each of COMARE's reports has been produced in response to a specific request for advice from UK government departments. The committee does not produce work for commercial companies or for the general public. AGNIR was a separate advisory committee that reported in turn to NRPB, HPA and finally PHE.

COMARE's work programme is available from its GOV.UK [webpage](#). The majority of COMARE's work to date has focused on the health effects of ionising radiation; however, the committee is kept up to date on studies of the possible health effects of electromagnetic fields (EMFs) through published information from a range of sources, as it becomes available, and evaluates the evidence to determine if further review is warranted.

COMARE has not previously reported on possible health effects from EMFs and at present there are no requests from government departments for the committee to provide advice on this issue.
