

Booking your seasonal vaccinations

Dear

You are a priority for seasonal flu and COVID-19 vaccinations. This is because you are aged 65 or over (by 31 March 2024).

Having your flu and COVID-19 vaccinations will reduce your risk of serious illness and help you recover more quickly if you catch the viruses.

How to get your COVID-19 vaccination

- Book online at www.nhs.uk/book-covid (you may be asked if you want a flu vaccination at the same appointment)
- Use the NHS App
- Visit www.nhs.uk/covid-walk-in to find your nearest COVID-19 vaccination walk-in site.

The last date you will be able to get your COVID-19 vaccination is **15 December 2023**.

How to get your flu vaccination

- Contact your GP surgery
- Visit www.nhs.uk/flu-pharmacy to find your nearest pharmacy offering the vaccine
- Some pharmacies are offering appointments online at www.nhs.uk/book-a-flu-vaccination or on the NHS App.

You will be able to get your flu vaccine after 15 December, but you are encouraged to get vaccinated as soon as you can ahead of the colder months.

• If you can't get online, phone **119** for help arranging your vaccinations.

If you usually get your care at home, please contact your GP surgery to arrange a **home visit** with a local NHS service. Go to **www.england.nhs.uk/local-covid-19-vaccination-contacts** if your GP surgery is unable to help.

Seasonal vaccinations have proven safety records. They give additional protection to any immunity you may have from previous infections.

Flu and COVID-19 spread more easily in winter. Even if you've been vaccinated before, it's important you get the protection you need because viruses change, and protection fades over time.
